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Semillon and Gewurztraminer: two international vines for a typically Sicilian wine, Passito. Only the genius of Giacomo Tachis, the greatest winemaker in Italian history, could conceive of such a combination. Giacomo was convinced that in Sicily any vine could be grown, based on Galileo Galilei's concept that wine is Light (of the sun) and Mood (of the earth). A wine of extraordinary elegance, dedicated to the great Giacomo Tachis.

Tasting notes: the aromatic notes and perfect acidity stand out. A product with balanced flavors, not excessively sweet and with clear hints of dried fruit, honey and rose.
