Frappato is one of the four single-varietal wines in the Colori di Sicilia line by Feudi del Pisciotto. This autochthonous black grape variety has ancient origins, and when vinified in purity, it highlights the typical floral and fruity aromas of the variety. The Frappato from Feudi del Pisciotto reveals vivacity and organoleptic intensity in the glass. Round on the palate, it captivates with its freshness. The label features strokes of fiery red that evoke the lava of the volcano, inspired by the ceramics of the great master from Caltagirone, Giacomo Alessi.

Tasting notes: ruby red with violet reflections. This wine ranges from hints of red fruits like strawberry and pomegranate to floral notes of rose and free-sia. On the palate, it is fragrant, soft, and well-balanced.

Pairings: grilled vegetables, cured meats, and dishes such as soups and stews, including fish.
